## Recommendations

- 1. Technical
  - Regional capacity and training program;

  - Clear in method development what can be implemented and what is still testing/research;
  - Social/economic and biodiversity indicators (safeguards);
  - MRV should cover all 5 activities under REDD+
  - Ngo's
- 2. Communication
  - Will at political level exists, but interface with technical/practical people  $\rightarrow$  action on the ground;
  - Focal points involvement;
  - Communication mechanisms (COMIFAC and countries and donors);
  - NGO role
  - Communicate to other sectors, be strategic on policy coherence across the board

## Recommendations 2

- 3. Coordination
  - Specific roles in countries and in region  $\rightarrow$  who do you talk to and call?
  - Further supporting REDD+ readiness programs
  - Regional platforms, with reservations on data sharing, accords etc.
- 4. Regional capacity and continuity:
  - No reason why there can be no similar level of monitoring as in other tropical regions;
  - Long term vision;
  - Workshops on annual basis?
- 5. Synergy
  - Points where countries can work together they could try this.
