







Result base payments for results of the implementation of activities



- Methodological guidance for non-market-based approaches
- Issues referred to methodological issues related to noncarbon benefits resulting from the implementation of REDD-plus
- The need for further guidance on the pending issues relating to safeguards, based on:
 - Parties views on experiences and lessons learned from their development of SIS, and the challenges they face in developing such systems
 - Parties and admitted observer organizations views on the type of information from SIS
